

About EHC LifeBuilders:

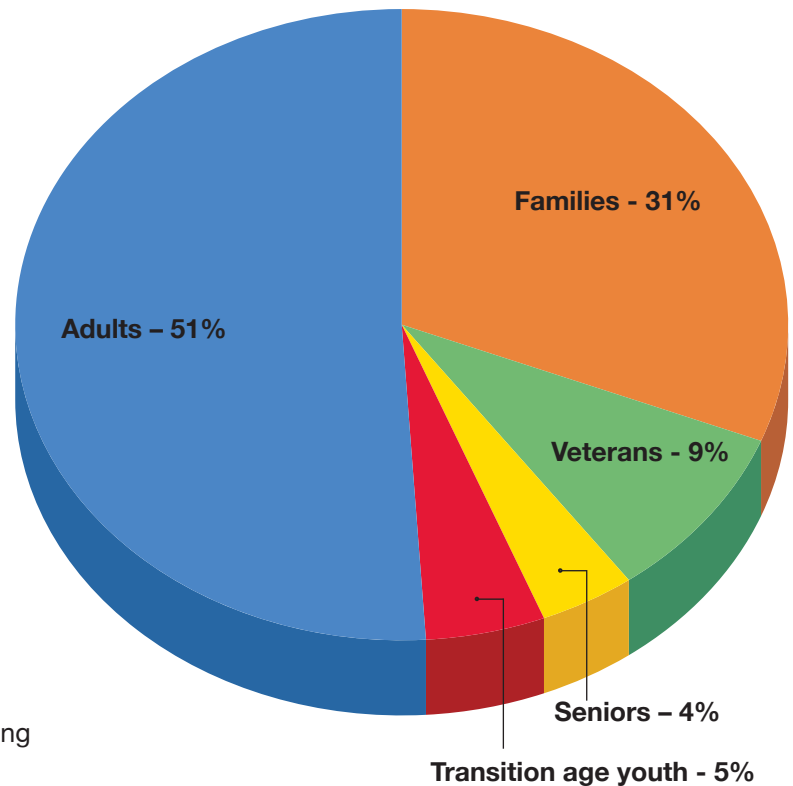
